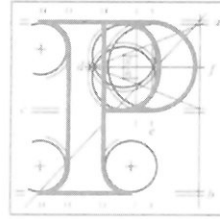

I would like to object to the proposed development of a resource recovery centre (including waste to energy facility) by Indaver NV t/a Indaver Ireland.

Observation details are that the facility site and surrounding area has changed since the original application. I appreciate that waste is an issue and must be dealt with, and that the development of new road infrastructure may be seen as a valid reason to think this development may go ahead but I do not. The whole area has moved on since the previous application.

My objections are based on the site being too small for purpose already and the boundary of the site has been changed to develop the M28 motorway and the area is subject to coastal erosion and is a known flood risk area which is a significant concern as the proposed facility is close to the shoreline.

Further the area has been zoned for educational purposes with the marine college in the locality and plans to extend and develop accommodation for students in the vicinity.

The proposed site, in the event of a fire would block people in the Naval Base, Crematorium and using the Haulbowline Island recreational Park.

The proposed facility is now in direct conflict with the current Cork Co Co development plans for the Harbour tourism and Fort Camden in particular having just been given funding last month.
