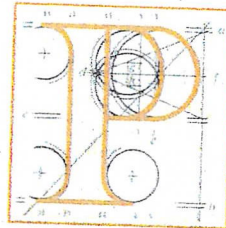


The Commission will revert to you in due course with regard to the matter.

**Observation on SID Application - Case Ref# PA04.318802, Ringaskiddy, Co. Cork**

We are writing to state our objection to the proposed building of an Incinerator in Ringaskiddy, Co. Cork.

Since this site was purchased by Indaver 24 years ago, all the land around it has been re-zoned for educational and recreational use. Building an Incinerator there now, which will be burning toxic waste and PFAS chemicals, would have a significant negative impact on public health and air quality.

We're living in an age when we should be working to **reduce** waste, rather than shipping in boatloads of waste from other countries to satisfy the capacity of this Incinerator.

It would also be an ugly blight on the natural beauty of Cork harbour.

We strongly urge you to refuse planning permission for this project.

And we wish to request an Oral Hearing to continue full public participation in this application.
