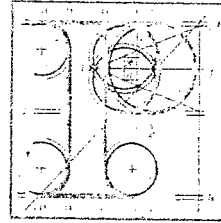

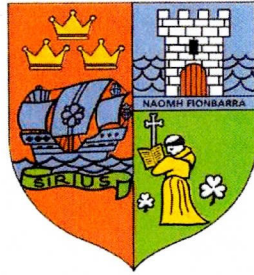

To whom it may concern,

On behalf of the Board of Management, staff and pupils of Scoil Barra Naofa I am writing to you to strongly object to the proposed planning application by Indaver Ireland for the construction of an incinerator in Ringaskiddy Co. Cork. Our school is situated in direct line with the proposed development and would have a detrimental effect on the health and wellbeing of our staff and pupils as the plant will more than likely emit toxic gases. The prevailing wind is in direct line with the tops of the stack and will blow these gases towards Monkstown where our school is situated. In addition, the visual aspect of the building and stack chimney will have a very negative impact on the beautiful views that we enjoy from the school. This proposed incinerator has been turned now by three inspectors of An Bord Pleanála and it is a disgrace to see another application for the same proposed development. It seems to me that this is a serious waste of taxpayers money as the planning application has been turned down three times by the inspectors of An Bord Pleanála previously over the past 24 years. The Port of Cork recently got permission to develop the port at Ringaskiddy which is now in operation. Ringaskiddy has contributed to the southern region of Ireland.

It is important that an oral hearing is held if An Coimisiún Pleanála don't reject the application.

I sincerely hope that An Coimisiún Pleanála refuses this application and puts this issue to bed permanently.
