The Authority acknowledges receipt of referral of the above Strategic Infrastructure Development application on behalf of Medite Europe DAC and provides the following observations for the Boards consideration;

In relation to the proposed development, the Authority has reviewed the development application documentation in the context of the DoECLG Spatial Planning and National Roads Guidelines for Planning Authorities (2012), and recommends the following provisions apply in any decision;

- The proposed development shall be undertaken strictly in accordance with the recommendations of the Transport (Traffic Impact) Assessment. Any recommendations arising should be incorporated as Conditions on the Permission, if granted. The developer should be advised that any additional works required as a result of the Assessment should be funded by the developer.
- The proposed development is located in proximity to a future national road scheme. National road schemes should be protected and kept free from any developments or accesses in accordance with national policy. The applicant should be made aware of the plans for a new road scheme should any permission be granted for the subject application.
- The Authority will entertain no future claims in respect of impacts (e.g. noise and visual) on the proposed development, if approved, due to the presence of the existing road or any new road scheme which is currently in planning.

It is requested that the above matters are taken into consideration prior to any decision on the subject application.
