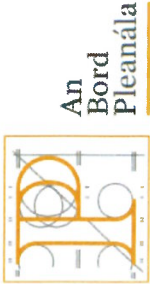

Development Description	Extraction of rock over an area of c. 14.2 ha comprising a lateral southerly extension to, and deepening of the existing quarry to a final depth of c. 114m AOD; the construction of internal haul roads, earthen screening bunds and storage landforms; the demolition of farm outbuildings (c. 126 sq. m.); the restoration of the site to biodiversity after uses primarily in the form of a waterbody and all ancillary works within an overall application area of c. 36.8 ha. An Environmental Impact Assessment Report was submitted as part of the application.
