- Crossing section drawings proposed (all assets and separation distances clearly labelled)

Following review of the application Uisce Éireann will determine if the proposals are acceptable and where appropriate issue a Diversion Agreement Offer or Build Over Agreement Offer to the Developer. Such Agreements are required to be paid for by the applicant and deemed executed by Uisce Éireann in advance of any works on the ground.
