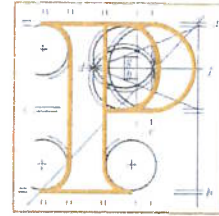

In relation to the Maherabeg Project Kerry County Council have now received funding approval from Fáilte Ireland to address accessibility issues with the current access from the proposed facility to the beach, as a component of the overall project.
