Palestinian Ambassador to
Ireland welcomed to Meath

Meath County Council welcomed the Palestinian Ambassador to Ireland Dr Jilan Wahba Abdalmajid and her guest, Senator Frances Black, to Buvinda House, Navan last week.

Cathaoirleach Sharon Tolan met with them and acknowledged the moment when on 22nd May, An Taoiseach Simon Harris together with Tánaiste Micheál Martin and Minister Eamon Ryan announced that Ireland would recognise the State of Palestine and she noted that with this act, "Ireland proudly stands among the 146 nations worldwide that have taken this significant step."

An Cathaoirleach further noted that this was not just a formal gesture but a potent symbol of political support and a testament to the aspirations of those who tirelessly advocate for a future marked by peace, democracy, and sovereignty." She called for a ceasefire, for the unconditional release of hostages and for unhindered access to humani-

arian aid, and that civilians, on all sides, must be protected under International Humanitarian Law.

Ambassador Abdalmajid asserted her desire to strengthen ties between the people of Palestine and the people of County Meath. She called for the people to do all they could to support calls to bring conflict in Gaza to a halt. Her guest, Frances Black is an Independent Senator, singer and founder of the RISE Foundation, a charitable organisation

working with people with a loved one in addiction.

A mother of three Dr Jilan Wahba Abdalmajid has a long career in the Palestinian diplomatic service. She began her diplomatic service at the Palestinian Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1995 as Assistant Chief of Protocol.

She was then posted in Cyprus where she completed her doctorate in Political Marketing, and she came to Ireland seven years ago as deputy to the former Am-

bassador. She presented her credentials as Ambassador of the State of Palestine to Ireland to President Higgins in January 2020.

Meath County Council Chief Executive, Kieran Kehoe, thanked the ambassador for taking the time to meet with the elected members of the council and noted the cross-party support in the council chamber for the people of Palestine. He further reiterated that the only pathway to peace is a political peace process.

Blackmail
and
pipe-bomb
charges

Two men were returned for trial from Drogheda District Court on charges of attempting to blackmail a local businessman while one of the two is also accused of placing a pipe bomb outside the businessman's home.

61-year-old Thomas O'Gorman, Old Balrath Post Office, Navan is accused of attempting to blackmail the businessman within the State between 26th August 2023 and with threatening to kill or cause serious harm to him by placing a viable pipe bomb and four rounds of ammunition at the man's house at Callstown, Clogherhead on 26th August 2023.

Meanwhile, 50-year-old Darren Cole, Foxhill Close, Coolock is accused of attempting to blackmail the businessman between the 26th August 2023 and 13th December 2023.

The judge also directed that any garda interviews with the accused be given to the defence.

Judge Liddy granted each of the accused free legal aid to cover the cost of a solicitor as well as one junior counsel and one senior counsel.

The judge remanded both men on bail to Dundalk Circuit Court on 8th October.

The court heard a book of evidence had been served on both accused and the Director of Public Prosecutions had directed they be returned for trial to the next sitting of Dundalk Circuit Court.
