Re: Upgrades to drainage infrastructure and construction of additional drainage infrastructure to improve performance of the surface water management with all associated site works. An Environmental Impact Assessment Report and a Natura Impact Statement accompany this planning application.

Date: 05 November 2024

Fingal County Council granted permission subject to 25 conditions for the above development on 21 August 2024. The Board received two 3rd party appeals from SMTW Environmental DAC and Wild Ireland Defence. A 1st party appeal against conditions 3, 14, 23 and 25 was also received.

The 3rd party appeal from SMTW Environmental DAC includes a USB copy of the appeal. The contents of the USB has been uploaded to the j drive for viewing.

These appeals were cross circulated on 17 & 18 September 2024. The circulation was repeated on 08 October 2024 to ensure full copies were received. The last day for receipt of responses was 04 November 2024.

Responses have been received from the 3rd party SMTW Environmental DAC, Fingal County Council and the applicant within the timeframe. It is not considered necessary to circulate these under section 131 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, (as emended).

No observations have also been received on the case

An EIAR and a NIS were submitted with the application These facts are mentioned in the application and Further Information notices. The green EIAR form and light green NIS form have been placed on file.

Fingal County Council invited and received comments from IAA, ANCA, DAU, DAA, Irish Water, NTA and the TII. No comments were received from An Taisce, The Heritage Council and the IFI. It is not considered necessary to invoke Article 28 of the Planning and Development Regulations at this time.

This file has been deemed a HP case as it is an application for a large scale infrastructure and economic importance.

The EIAR requires uploading to the Board's website in accordance with procedures. Also, following decision a full copy of all appeal documents will need to be published to the website. The file should be reviewed and required documentation scanned and saved. A blue EIAR sticker is on front of file.
