We have received a response to the request for Further information by the Board on 17/12/24 from Galway County Council on 16/07/25.

The information received includes an updated NIS and CEMP which contain significant additional data relating to the likely significant effects of the proposed development on a European site. For that reason, I recommend that the proposed development should be subject to new notices as described in section 177AE(5)(d) of the Planning and Development Act 2000 as amended.

I recommend that the local authority be limited to 2 weeks for response to our request to readvertise, and that the public be given no less than 6 weeks to respond to the significant FI following publication of notices by the local authority.
