

## **Ummamore Renewable Energy Development**

We the owners of house no. 28 on map provided to us by Enerco wish to object to the above development on the following grounds.

The visual impact will be very severe and unacceptable. No proper wind monitoring was completed as both wind monitoring mast erected by developer collapsed on two occasions.

The SEAI Wind Atlas reports low average wind speeds for the proposed site. The area is also designated as low wind are in Westmeath County Development Plan. The planning application refers to "low capacity" of the site.

Our property will be surrounded on three sides. All nine of these turbines will be within 1 kilometre distance from our dwelling.

More than half our farm is within the 750 metre boundary. In the case of this development wind turbines should not be placed 324 metres not as mentioned 7.19 of planning application from Non Participating Land owners boundary as per Wind Energy Guidelines which is not so in this case see attached map. Enerco cannot take wind from non-consenting land owners. T2 is to be located 294 metres from our land boundary. T6 is to be located 320 metres from our land boundary which is in breach of planning. Please find attached maps highlighting this Folio WH2606.

This area has the last remaining wetland in this area, which has a large population of snipe and lapwing, we also have a healthy population of otters. This company Enerco have been involved in one ecological disaster so they have no respect for people or wildlife. Please find attached photos of otters playing on our land. This is a quiet rural area noise emitted by industrial turbines of this size would destroy the quality of the local environment and natural habitat also potential health consequences—due to sleep disturbances all homes will be subjected to shadow flicker due to turbine blades blocking sunlight.

Currently our daughter who is a vet and travelling abroad plans on returning in the near future to take over the running of this farm. If this development proceeds it will limit and restrict the type of farming which she wishes to pursue and would be impossible if this development goes ahead due to the closeness and over powering height of these turbines.

From the outset of this proposed development the approach has progressed to this stage tinged with lies, deceit and hush money offered to gullible people not realising the long term consequences of these windfarms which would be better off located in the sea where there is constant wind in abundance.
