- 1. The lands as referred to and detailed in the Schedule in the attached report and accompanying maps be acquired compulsorily.
- 2. To extinguish the public rights of way described in the Schedule of the attached report and accompanying maps.
- 3. To restrict or otherwise interfere with the public rights of way described the Schedule of the report and accompanying maps.
- 4. To acquire the private rights as described in the Schedule of the report and accompanying maps.
- 5. To restrict or otherwise interfere with the private rights described in the Schedule of the report and accompanying maps.
- 6. To temporarily restrict or otherwise interfere with the private rights described in the Schedule of the report and accompanying maps.
- 7. That the Compulsory Purchase Order as aforesaid be prepared in the prescribed form, being for the purpose of the construction of BusConnects Galway: Dublin Road Development in the City of Galway, together with the ancillary works associated therewith, and for the purposes of providing infrastructure to facilitate BusConnects Galway: Dublin Road Development and that the Official Seal of Galway City Council is to be affixed to the Compulsory Purchase Order and accompanying maps.
- 8. The statutory procedures to acquire the lands and or rights the subject of the Compulsory Purchase Order be commenced
- 9. All statutory advertisements and notices be published and served in relation to the Compulsory Purchase Order.
- 10. The Compulsory Purchase Order, and the maps attached thereto, be sealed with the seal of the Galway City Council and submitted to An Bord Pleanála for confirmation.
