The Planning Authority wish to acknowledge receipt of your correspondence of 3/1/2023.

It is noted that you state Mr. Rock now wishes to 'de-structure' the two unauthorised sheds on the site.

You are advised that it remains open to you to remove the said unauthorised sheds in accordance with the terms of the Enforcement Notice which required the removal of same.

As you are aware the Council were ready to progress to hearing in court on this matter on 24/11/2022 and our witness was present in court, but at the request of Counsel acting on behalf of Mr. Rock the Council agreed to adjourn proceedings. It was indicated to the court at that time that Mr. Rock was seeking the adjournment in order to make a substitute consent application to An Bord Pleanála.

It remains the position of the Planning Authority that we are ready for the case to go to hearing should the said application not be lodged with An Bord Pleanála or the Enforcement File complied with, by the time the case is next for mention on 23/3/2023.
