Pursuant to Section 177AE of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended), and the requirements of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), we hereby give notice that an application, including a Natura Impact Statement and relevant plans and particulars, for a proposed development comprising of the rehabilitation of an existing protected 7 arch stone masonry structure. There is no demolition or new build involved. The Natura Impact Statement, including the plans and particulars for the proposed development, will be placed on public display from Thursday the 3rd of April 2025 Until Friday the 16th of May 2025.

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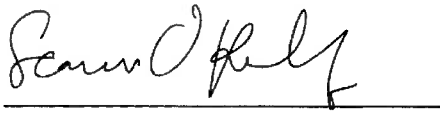

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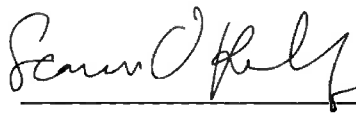
