By order dated 6th May, 2025 Tipperary County Council granted subject to conditions the above development.

Three Third Party appeals have been lodged with the Board.

An NIS and an EIAR accompanied the application and were revised with Further information. (public notices reflect same)

An Taisce, Irish water, Health and Safety Authority, Development Applications Unit and Environmental Protection Agency have made submissions to The Planning

Authority on the application. It is not recommended to further invoke Art 28 at this stage. However, as this development may require a licence and was accompanied by an EIAR, it is recommended to follow the procedures for EPA consultation. (Draft letter attached for inspector).
