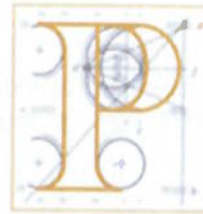

A copy of this submission should also be placed on the public file when sent to the Commission. For the purpose of any necessary clarification please be advised that the planning authority submission on an application for approval under section 182A is not subject to any statutory requirement relating to the formal submission of a manager's report to the elected members of the Council prior to making a submission to the Commission (such a statutory requirement only applies to applications for planning permission under section 37E of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended) - it is of course open to you to consult the elected members if you so choose to do but the time limit for your submission to the Commission must still be met.
