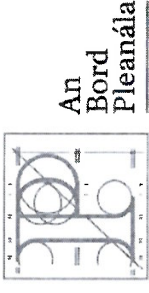



NOISE is also a real threat to our health, wellbeing and peace of mind
