Point 1:

No opportunity given to the Community to respond to the RFI response by the developers submitted on 28th March 2025

The opportunity to respond to the RFI response from Tullacondra Green Energy was taken away from the general public. The outcome may have been difference at Council level if we did get this opportunity, now instead we must take this appeal to An Bord Pleanala. This amounts to a definite prejudice against the whole community.

Point 2:

The Vestas documentation explains the risk that arises from the sheer size and scale of this make and model wind turbine.

At section 2.1.1 of Vestas documentation "Approach to the Wind Turbine" it states "Adults must keep children under close surveillance. Do not stand beneath the rotor or near the wind turbine when the rotor blades are covered with ice"

Section 2 says "Do not stay within a radius of 400 meters from the turbine unless it is necessary." "Make sure that children do not stay by or play near the turbine. If necessary fence the foundation."

My family and I have land within 400 meters of proposed turbines, therefore there is a major safety issue here. My family and future generations of children on the farm will not be safe to walk around their own land. This has completely overlooked and is detrimental to the health and well-being of all persons in the community.

Point 3:

On my farm, we have various wildlife along with a variety of diverse and native species which shares a boundary with two of the proposed landowners. For example, there are barn owls, kestrels, bats and various other animals.

In recent times, otters have been spotted regularly on our land in an estuary that attaches to the Awbeg River. Therefore, this development will majorly impact these habitats.

Point 4:

I have major concerns over the noise off the proposed turbines, my family home in 800m away from two of the proposed turbines 1 and 2

I have major concerns about the future of the Lisgriffin/ Ballyclough area, I personally would not be prepared to build a home and have a family living near these colossal turbines in the middle of a populated area. Common sense wouldn't allow this to happen.

Point 5:

I would have serious concerns on how this proposed development could affect the health of both Equine and Bovine animals. My family farm is far too close to this wind farm development.
