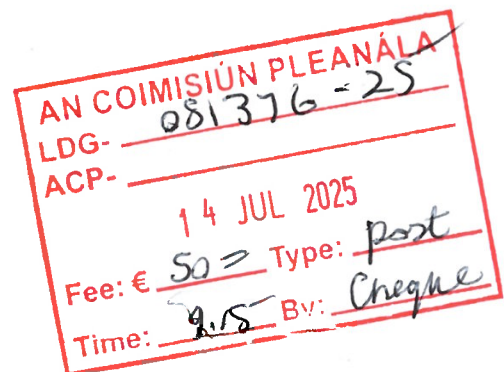

TRYING TO GET PLANNING PERMISSION IN THE AREA WOULD BE ALSO BE DIFFICULT. IT IS ALSO AN EXTREMELY BUSY ROAD AND I FEEL THAT THE TRAFFIC IS ALREADY EXCESSIVE WITHOUT THIS DEVELOPMENT GOING AHEAD.
