Following a review of the further information documentation received by the Coimisiún on the 23rd March 2026, I consider that the further information received is not significant on the basis that the redline boundary, road alignment and conclusions of the submitted NIS, CEMP, EIA screening and EclA reports have remained unchanged.

The width of the carriageway has increased slightly by 0.3m from 2.7m to 3.0m as shown on drawing reference number 1202 however I do not consider this a significant amendment.


In order to assist with the Coimisiún's assessment of this application. I consider it appropriate to request the applicant to submit the targeted Habitat Survey Report (March 2026), written by Roger Goodwillie & Associates which has informed the revised NIS, CEMP, EIA screening and EclA reports.

The further information documentation received including the Habitat Survey Report should be circulated to the prescribed bodies for comments with a 2 week response period.
