### **COMPULSORY ACQUISITION OF LANDS AND RIGHTS OVER LAND**

UISCE ÉIREANN COMPULSORY PURCHASE (TAGOAT WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADE)
ORDER, 2025

### **ENGINEERS REPORT**

To: Chief Executive Officer, Uisce Éireann

Date: May 2025

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- 6. The Tagoat WWTP has failed to meet the Effluent Limit Values (ELV's) specified in the Wastewater Discharge Licence (WWDL) in respect of ortho-Phosphate and ammonia. An assessment of assimilative capacity on the Tagoat stream has demonstrated that adequate assimilative capacity is not available in the stream either at the existing outfall or at any point further downstream.
- 7. Uisce Éireann proposes to abandon the discharge of treated wastewater to the Tagoat stream due to the discharge quality not meeting the WWDL. This will be achieved through the abandonment of the existing wastewater treatment facility and the development of a wastewater transfer pumping station, incorporating an overflow holding tank, along with a transfer rising main the Rosslare Harbour agglomeration network at Kilrane Cross.

### Description of the Scheme & Public Interest




Figure 1: Wastewater Sewer Network in Tagoat

8. Generally, the scheme consists of the provision of a new Wastewater Pumping Station (WWPS)with submersible pumps capable of delivering a flow of 8.89ls through a 140mm Outside diameter rising main pipeline to Rosslare Harbour agglomeration. The new pumping station will be located at the site of the existing wastewater treatment plant, this is located in the townland of Grahormack, to the west of Tagoat village as shown in Figure 1.

The pumping station shall be complete with ultrasonic level probes, valve chamber with over pumping bowser, gas ram assist access covers with safety grids, penstock on inlet manhole, control kiosk, water supply at wet kiosk and site lighting. It will also include an emergency

- 16. In the Republic of Ireland, the Urban Waste Water Treatment Regulations 2001-2010 ('the Regulations') set requirements on the provision of waste water collection systems and treatment plants, provide for the monitoring of waste water discharges and specify limits for certain parameters in the discharges.
- 17. Uisce Éireann's Water Services Strategic Plan 2015 (WSSP) sets out Uisce Éireann's strategic objectives for the delivery of water services up to 2040 to ensure the availability of safe drinking water, an environment that is protected from the impacts of wastewater discharges, and efficient modern systems that meet the needs of customers, contribute to economic growth and development, and provide value for money.
- 18. The proposed development at the Tagoat wastewater treatment plant will support Objective 5 of the WSSP (Water Services Strategic Plan 2015) (Provide Effective Management of Wastewater).
- 19. In the draft plan, a number of Strategic Aims and Actions are directly relevant to the Tagoat project.

Strategic Aim: Protecting our Water Environment

Action 3.3: Ensure sustainable abstractions and manage water treatment residuals.

Strategic Aim: Playing Our Part under the Water Framework Directive

Action 3.5: Manage wastewater services throughout the asset lifecycle to achieve regulatory requirements.

Strategic Aim: Providing for Growth

Action 2.7: Engage with housing and industry stakeholders to support delivery of new homes and economic growth

### The Need for these Lands

- 20. The CPO is required to facilitate the construction of elements of the scheme, namely the pumping station, gravity sewer diversions, new entrance road and sections of the wastewater rising main. It should be noted that there are other elements of the scheme where CPO is not required due to works being in the public roadway.
- 21. During the preliminary design process numerous pipe routes and options for enhanced treatment process and outfall relocation were examined with the current proposed scheme being the most feasible. However, it was determined that lands not in the ownership of Wexford County Council/ Uisce Éireann would be required. These lands consisted of:

One permanent land acquisition at the existing Wastewater Treatment Plant for pumpstation construction;

Eight permanent wayleaves along the existing sewers and proposed rising main route;

- a) Upgrade Wastewater Treatment Plant at Tagoat with chemical treatment and/ or upgraded expanded treatment units;
- Relocate Outfall further downstream on the Tagoat stream/Milltown\_Rosslare sub-catchment either on its own or in combination with an upgraded treatment facility at Tagoat;
- Abandon wastewater treatment at Tagoat and pump away to Rosslare Harbour wastewater treatment plant approximately 4km away.
- d) 6 No. route options were considered and assessed in respect of the pump away option considering alternative pipeline routes and connection points to the network at Rosslare Harbour.
- 27. I am satisfied that all reasonable alternatives as outlined above and in the Route and Selection Report of T.J. O'Connor & Associates, Consulting Engineers, dated October 2023 have been fully considered and are not demonstrably preferable and that these lands, permanent wayleaves, temporary working areas and Rights of Ways are necessary for the Tagoat Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade Project and are suitable for the purpose for which they are required.

### Works are not in Contravention of the Provisions of the Statutory Development Plan

- 28. The Wexford County Development Plan 2022-2028 (CDP) supports the proposed works through Objective WW007, committing Wexford County Council to work with Irish Water, other public infrastructure agencies and local communities to develop the programme for 'new homes in small towns and villages' as set out in NPO 18b of the National Planning Framework for the settlements listed in Table 9-6 (of the Development Plan). Tagoat is identified as a Level 4 settlement (Large Village) and is included in the settlements listed in Table 9-6.
- 29. The Planning Exemptions Assessment Report in support of the Compulsory Purchase Order, prepared by TJ O'Connor & HW Planning, expands on the fact that development, as identified in growth targets for Tagoat in the CDP, cannot be delivered prior to the resolution of existing wastewater treatment and receiving water constraints.

### **Planning Status**

30. This project does not require planning permission. At this stage of the project, it is confirmed that the project will be exempt from requiring planning permission. A Planning Exemptions Assessment Report has been produced and is enclosed:

### Conclusion

I am satisfied that all reasonable alternatives have been fully considered and these lands and rights over land are necessary for this scheme and suitable for the purpose for which they are required. I am also satisfied that Uisce Éireann requires to invoke the Compulsory Purchase Order procedure for the lands and rights over land required as it is unlikely that all of the foregoing could be required by agreement with the relevant Landowners with full title or otherwise in a timely fashion.
- 35. Accordingly, it is recommended that Uisce Éireann make the Uisce Éireann Compulsory Purchase (Tagoat Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade) Order, 2025.
