

The National Transport Authority (the "NTA") has reviewed the above referenced planning application and, based on the Limerick-Shannon Metropolitan Area Transport Strategy (LSMATS), which is a consideration material to the planning process, makes the following observations and recommendations.

The NTA, as a funding authority for active travel works in Limerick City and County Council area, welcome the application for the proposed development. The Limerick City Greenway will provide significantly enhanced active travel infrastructure in the east of city, linking the city, University of Limerick and the suburbs together via a high-quality active travel corridor. The provision of this enhanced infrastructure will assist with unlocking active travel potential and encouraging modal shift in the city.
