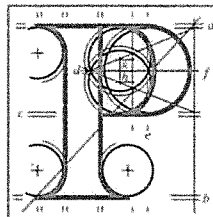

Development Description

Proposed Limerick City Greenway (UL to NTP)

A Chara,

As the National Water Utility Uisce Éireann delivers water services pursuant to the Water Services Act (and other legislation) and in accordance with our statutory functions and ancillary responsibilities and in a manner which is consistent with public policy.

Uisce Éireann is responsible for the delivery of all public water and wastewater services in Ireland. We are committed to continuously upgrading and developing critical infrastructure to support growth in our economy, while protecting the environment and safeguarding water supplies. Our primary function is to provide clean drinking water to customers and to treat and return wastewater safely to the environment. In providing these services we play a central role in enabling economic growth, protecting both the environment and the health and safety of our customers and the wider public.

Please accept this submission in respect of the above-referenced Strategic Infrastructure Development application.

Provision of Water & Wastewater services

No new connections to Uisce Éireann's water and wastewater networks are included in the applicant's proposal.

Public infrastructure

In respect to proposals under HA91.323410, Uisce Éireann notes the presence of much in situ network infrastructure along the development area of the proposed greenway. Primarily these assets comprise a 900mm sewer main running along the existing walkways on the banks of the River, and also a 450 mm concrete watermain running north to the river alongside University Road. Further to this the Castletroy Wastewater treatment plant is present along the route north of the Dromroe student village.

Consultations have been undertaken with Uisce Éireann in relation to these assets. It has been assessed that impacts to these assets are not anticipated, with the applicant undertaking measures to avoid unplanned disruptions to services during the proposed works. This will include thorough investigations to identify and reconfirm the location of all utility infrastructure within the works areas, and the implementation of robust procedures when undertaking works in the around known infrastructure services.

Uisce Éireann requires that in such works, its assets are protected during the construction & operation phases of the development, and that the required separation distances are achieved between Uisce Éireann's assets and the underground cable(s), and that any development near assets shall be carried out in compliance with Uisce Éireann's Technical Standards, Codes of Practice, Standard Details and other associated Uisce Éireann requirements. Where the safety of assets cannot be assured, and where appropriate separation distances cannot be achieved, the applicant shall submit a diversion's enquiry with Uisce Éireann's diversions section (diversions@water.ie) prior to the commencement of works.
