Dear Sir or Madam,

I wish to object to the proposed wind turbine development at the above address by the above-named company, Garrane Green Energy Wind Farm.

I live close to the proposed site and have serious concerns regarding its impact on residents and the local environment.

1. Noise and shadow flicker, especially at night, seriously effecting nearby homes.
2. Visual impact – the turbines would dominate the rural landscape, spoiling scenic views and reducing local amenity value.
3. Wildlife and environment – The project will threaten local bird and bat populations and may disturb drainage and natural habitats.
4. Traffic and safety – Construction traffic on local rural roads would pose safety risks and damage road surfaces.
5. Lack of consultation – Residents have not been informed or consulted about the full scale and impact of this development.
6. In conflict with County Development Plan (Limerick) – the proposal is inconsistent with policies protecting rural character and residential amenity.

For these reasons, I strongly urge you, the Secretary, An Coimisiún Pleanála, to refuse planning permission for this development.
