② Ive witnessed severe flooding in all four
 seasons of the year, Sometimes Two and
 three times a week when Persistent

 that bounds the river Maigue.

③ Ive witnessed flooding of the N 20
 which runs outside my house, impassible
 @ the Maigue bridge and at the
 River Creggan Bridge which flows into
 the Maigue.

On many occasion Ive witnessed a Pair
 of Beautiful Swans to Swim around the fields.

Why am I against this Development.

The Proposed Development of 9 mega turbines, will have on this low lying Class A flood Plain.

Where can the Excess flooding go to when it comes that spreads out across the land, and recedes back into the river maigue, which sometimes takes Days to eventually clear before it starts all over again.

This Proposed Development is Proposing 5 Km's of Roadways Hard Stand areas for Each turbine, Huge Concrete Bases above ground Level for turbines to sit on above water level.

Where will the flood water that covers this area go to Several times a year. With Reduced Area of Soakage from hard Stand and Concrete bases this Development has the Potential to Cause huge flooding of my House and many more, it will cause severe flooding of the N20 and the L1538

These turbines and associated Site works roadways bases Sub Station etc. were to commence it would mean massive destruction of the natural flow of flood water that comes out and flows back into the river maigue many times a year.
