I write to express an observation on behalf of concerned constituents on the Cork County Council side of the border re the proposed planning application for wind farms Garrane, Bruree, Co. Limerick.

Due to the extent of this development and estimated number of vehicles needed in the construction and implementation stage, I am concerned that the proposed circular traffic management plan using the N20 to Charleville, relief Ballincolly road and Kilmallock road, is totally inadequate.

Charleville town is the retail, commercial hub of North Cork and South Limerick. At present, it experiences gridlock on must busy days, facilitating already over 16,000 vehicles per day through the town. I am concerned that the addition of these vehicles for the proposed development will interfere with the business, industrial and community activities in our town.
