Development Description:

The proposed development consists of the rehabilitation of the existing Carrowrevagh Bridge on the N59 National Secondary Road. The proposed works comprise;

Reinstatement of original bed levels at the upstream elevation of the structure, Masonry repairs and repointing to the masonry arch section of the bridge, Localised concrete repairs to the reinforced concrete deck slab soffit, Installation of rock armour to the northeast embankment downstream of the structure. Increasing the height of the existing bridge parapets using masonry construction, Waterproofing the existing reinforced concrete deck slab, Installation of safety barriers on both verges over the structure and on approaches.



Please accept this submission in respect to the above-referenced planning application. Uisce Éireann (UÉ) has reviewed the plans and particulars submitted with the application and have the following observation(s).

Uisce Éireann's Assessment/Observation(s):

Uisce Éireann notes the presence of a 110mm HDPE watermain running parrarel to the N59 and through the project area.

Please note that that Uisce Éireann cannot permit any negative impact to its network assets, in any works that may impact minimum separation distances per Uisce Éireann's standard codes and practices must be achieved. If it is anticipated that such distances cannot be achieved, the applicant is required to liase with Uisce Éireann's diversions team at diversions@water.ie to find a suitable mitigation.



Uisce Éireann's Standard Condition(s):

The applicant shall enter into a Connection Agreement(s) with Uisce Éireann to provide for a service connection(s) to the public water supply and/or wastewater collection network and adhere to the standards and conditions set out in that agreement.

All development shall be carried out in compliance with Uisce Éireann's Standard Details and Codes of Practice.

Uisce Éireann does not permit Build Over of its assets. Where the applicant proposes to build over or divert existing water or wastewater services the applicant shall have received written Confirmation of Feasibility (COF) of Diversion(s) from Uisce Éireann prior to any works commencing.
