A Chara,

I wish to make a submission in respect of the above-referenced substitute consent application.

1. Transport Infrastructure TII

The proposed entrance where we have heard the blades for the turbines will be brought in is along the N62, a very busy road. An important road between Birr and Athlone and gateway linking the north west of the country with the south.

In my own locality, in Ballycumber, we have been led to believe there will be heavy duty vehicles travelling along our country roads. A few years ago, we had an issue with a sand and gravel company travelling our roads with 30 ton lorries. The roads were completely destroyed as they were not built for such heavy continuous traffic. The roads are already in bad condition. There is flooding issues during winter months. We do not need any further disruption to our roads.

2. Historical acquisition of the lands

My family were the victim of bogland acquired by Bord na Mona against their will. My father-in-law was a BnM worker. He was told by his manager that he would lose his job if he did not sign over his holding to Bord na Mona. This can only be described as taking advantage of a vulnerable old man. He was paid pittance for his bog which had been in the family for many years.

3. Effects on human health

We have heard from neighbouring communities about the noise and the shadow flicker from the turbines. It is not acceptable for BnM to tell us to keep our windows and curtains closed. We built our houses and followed every condition set down by the county council. We are entitled to enjoy the results of our work instead of shutting ourselves in all day and night

I request that this submission be taken into account and that I be notified of the decision in due course.
