

Shancloon Windfarm Case Ref Number 323699

We wish to formally object to the above proposed development on the following grounds:

We live in Cloonteen Approximately 749mtrs from the proposed windfarm.

We have lived here for 19 years, with our two children

The proposed turbines are located unacceptably close to my home. We are deeply concerned about the effects of noise, low-frequency sound, and shadow flicker, which are known to cause sleep disturbance, stress, and headaches. I suffer from severe vertigo and recurring headaches, and such disturbances would significantly worsen my condition and cause unnecessary anxiety & stress

My family and I chose to build our home in Cloonteen because of its peaceful, rural environment. This development would completely alter the character and tranquillity of the area, turning it into an industrial zone unsuitable for residential living due to the proximity of the turbines

We have a child with a learning disability who finds it difficult to concentrate. Continuous noise and flicker from nearby turbines would have a serious and lasting impact on their ability to learn, rest, and function comfortably in their own home.

We were promised regular updates and meaningful engagement from RWE, but this has not happened. We have not received proper information about noise, shadow flicker, or environmental assessments. Local residents have been left feeling excluded, abandoned, and disregarded throughout this process.

The proposed development site lies within sensitive bogland that supports a variety of species, including bats, birds, and wild deer. The construction and operation of large-scale turbines will destroy habitats, disturb wildlife, and irreversibly damage the natural landscape. This area is a valuable part of our local ecosystem and deserves protection.

We fear for our children's future here and the complications it may cause for future housing and living conditions.

We as a family deserve to live in our home that we have worked so hard for without worry and fear.

For the reasons outlined above—relating to health, wellbeing, environmental protection, lack of consultation, and the preservation of our beautiful homelands character We strongly object.
