**Re:** Objection to Shancloon Windfarm (ACP Ref: 323699)

Dear Sir/Madam,

We, Shauna and Padraic Fahy, are writing to formally object to the proposed Shancloon Windfarm development. We live in Cloonaglasha, Tuam, where Shauna has lived all her life and Padraic for the past eleven years. We chose to raise our family here because of the peace and calmness of the countryside, the sense of community, and the safety of the quiet country roads where our children can walk and play.

Our main concerns relate to the destruction of the bog and the serious impact this will have on the local ecosystem, water systems, and wildlife. Peatlands are vital for regulating water flow, and their disturbance can lead to flooding and contamination, which would have devastating consequences for local homes and private wells.

We are also deeply worried about the noise from the turbines, the loss of peace and quiet, and the severe visual impact the development would have on this beautiful rural landscape. Shauna suffers from vertigo, and we are very concerned that shadow flicker from the turbines could trigger her symptoms. Others in the area, including those with epilepsy, could also be affected.

We are concerned too about the potential devaluation of our property and the difficulties future generations may face in obtaining planning permission. The constant construction traffic, noise, and activity would disrupt daily life and destroy the tranquillity we and our neighbours value so much.

There has been no meaningful consultation with local residents. Despite requests, no proper public meeting was held in the evenings in local venues such as Kilconly or Caherlistrane, when people could attend. This lack of engagement shows a complete disregard for the people who will be most affected by this development.

We believe this project poses unacceptable risks to our environment, our health, and our community's quality of life. We therefore strongly urge An Coimisiún Pleanála to refuse permission for the Shancloon Windfarm.
