NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF A COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER UNDER SECTION 74 OF AND THE THIRD SCHEDULE TO THE HOUSING ACT 1966 AS EXTENDED BY SECTION 50 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (No. 2) ACT 1968 (AS SUBSTITUTED BY SECTION 50 OF THE HOUSING ACT 1966) AND AMENDED AND EXTENDED BY SECTION 8 AND THE SECOND SCHEDULE OF THE ROADS ACT 1993 AND AMENDED BY THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACTS 2000 - 2023

SLIGO COUNTY COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as "the Local Authority") in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 74 of the Housing Act 1966 and the Third Schedule thereto, as extended by section 50 of the Local Government (No. 2) Act 1968 as substituted by section 50 of the Housing Act 1966 as amended by section 8 and the Second Schedule to the Roads Act 1993 and the Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2023 and in particular by section 227 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the above mentioned legislation and in particular section 213 of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended hereby makes an Order enabled as above which is to be submitted to An Boinn (hereafter "the Board") for confirmation. If confirmed, the order will authorise the Local Authority to acquire compulsorily the land described in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of the development of the City Campus - Sligo's Cultural and Learning Hub and all ancillary works associated therewith.

Owners, lessees and occupiers of the land described in the Schedule will receive individual written notice. The Board cannot confirm a compulsory purchase order in respect of the land if an objection is made in respect of the acquisition by an owner, lessee or occupier of the land, and not withdrawn, until it has decided to be held as an oral hearing into the matter and until it has considered the objection and the report of the person who held the oral hearing.

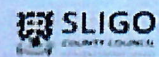
