RE: Proposed Tirawley Windfarm Project, Strategic Infrastructure Development Application to An Coimisiún Pleanála under Section 37(E) of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended)

Dear Sirs,

Constant Energy Limited gives notice of its intention to make an application to An Coimisiún Pleanála for permission for the development of Tirawley Windfarm project including the Grid Connection in the townlands of Aghaleague, Ballymurphy, Ballynaleck, Barnhill Lower, Barnhill Upper, Barroe, Billoos, Carn, Carrickanass, Carrowmore, Castlelackan Demesne, Castletown, Cloonanass, Conaghra, Glebe, Lackanhill, Lecarrowntemple, Lissadrone East and Lissadrone West, Co. Mayo. The Grid Connection Route will commence in the townlands of Barroe and will continue onto the townlands of Carrad More, Tawnaghmore Upper, Rathbaun, Carrickanass, Cloonavarry, Doonamona, Rathcash, Castlereagh, Rathowen West, Rathowen East, Magherabrack, Cloonawillin, Killala, Mullafarry, Lisglennon, Tawnaghmore Lower, Ballinteean and Carrowreagh Co Mayo.

The full planning application, Environmental Impact Assessment Report and Natura Impact Statement can be viewed on the dedicated project website (www.tirawleywindfarm.com) or may be inspected free of charge or purchased on payment of a specified fee (which fee shall not exceed the reasonable cost of making such a copy) during public opening hours at the following locations:

- The Offices of An Coimisiún Pleanála, 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1, D01 V902.
- The Offices of Mayo County Council, Aras an Chontae, The Mall, Castlebar, County Mayo F23WF90.

In considering this application, An Coimisiún Pleanála can decide to:

- (a) (i) grant the permission, or
(ii) make such modifications to the proposed development as it specifies in its decision and grant permission in respect of the proposed development as so modified, or

(iii) grant permission in respect of part of the proposed development (with or without specified modifications of it of the foregoing kind), and any of the above decisions may be subject to or without conditions,

or

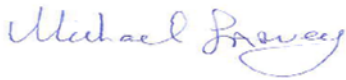
(b) refuse to grant the permission.

Any submissions/observations must be made to the Commission at 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1, D01 V902 relating to:

- (i) the implications of the proposed development for proper planning and sustainable development of the area concerned, and
- (ii) the likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, if carried out, and
- (iii) the likely effects or adverse effects on the integrity of a European site, if carried out.

Any submissions/observations must be received by the Commission not later than 5.30pm on the 25th of November 2025.
