As a family we wish to object strongly to this proposal and ask that the Board refuse planning permission.

We have 2 planned turbines within 2.5km of our home, yet we have not been contacted by developers to provide information or ask for our thoughts on this planned development. This is simply not acceptable.

Our property is situated on an elevated site with a beautiful view of the surrounding area. This view will be greatly impacted with this planned development.

As a family this will have a number of implications for us:

- Proximity to our home has the potential to devalue our property and deny us a fair return on any potential sale of this property.
- It has been reported that turbines of this size can cause health complications such as migraines.
- We moved to this beautiful setting partly for the wonderful views and peace it offers. These views will be distorted with such development.
- The construction of such a wind farm will also have serious consequences for the wildlife of our area and the ecosystem that exists here. No permission has been granted by residents for such destruction.
- The area where this development is planned for, is also not identified as a prosperous area for wind generation, thereby clarifying that this project is about profit and not sustainable energy


5. Grounds

- This development if approved will have a negative affect on our children's lives in the future as it will cause great uncertainty regarding where they may be able to build their own homes. Planning permission in the area will be affected due to this development leading to a move away of the youth from this area.
- The building phase of this development will also have a massive negative affect for us as a family. I operated a transport business in the local area. The disruption caused by development will have a serious knock on affect for my business and has the potential to affect future earning for me.

We are deeply concerned that a development of this magnitude could go ahead without the consideration of those who will be mostly affected.

We request an oral hearing for the development of this wind farm for the reasons outlined above.
