We, Anna & Joe Shinnors, write in connection with the above listed planning application. We wish to object strongly to this proposal and ask that the Board refuse the planning permission.

Some of our summarised observations and concerns are as follows;

1. The effect that this will have on people being granted planning permission in the area
2. Noise and Sleep Disturbance
3. Running cables along the R512 will disrupt an already extremely busy and dangerous road
4. Effects on Water Supply which comes to our property via the R512
5. Wil properties in this area be devalued if this wind farm goes ahead?
6. Our family farm is located on two sides of the R512 – any disruption will affect our ability to efficiently carry out our work and will upset our livestock.
7. A member of our household works from home full time – potential disruptions to power/broadband while works are ongoing will be detrimental
8. Wind Turbines will detract from the natural beauty in the area e.g. Lough Gur, Grange Stone Circle
