Some of our summarised observations and concerns are as follows:

I am a landowner in Athlacca, I am worried about my land that it could be impacted from flooding as I live close to the River Maigue. I have lived here all my life and I'm worried about my land and property value. Wildlife is very important to me. I have a fox-cover close by. I have a private well and will this be impacted if the water tables are disturbed.

Swans often stop at my home by the River
maigue on their flight path to Lough Guin. I'm
afraid if these turbines are constructed our
Wildlife will be destroyed.

Extra traffic load on our small local roads
which are not able to cope with big heavy
good vehicles.

Noise will be heard from my home, and
the biggest impact my view of our beautiful
Golden Vale from my home will be destroyed
if these turbines are built.

My land is prime agricultural land - best
land in Ireland, my land will be of less value.
visual dominance of industrialisation instead
of natural beauty.

Loss of Biodiversity, the construction and
turbine operation will reduce biodiversity.

My health and enjoyment will be taken
from my home, and the natural beauty around
me if these turbines x17 industrial size are
built.

The low frequency noise will impact by health
my peace and tranquility will be gone
forever.

Our Natural heritage, protected species and habitats will be decimated. Our Irish Culture and tourism will be destroyed in our community. I disagree with Dúnceick County being used as zoning that is disproportionate and inappropriate for this area.

I ~~we~~ strongly urge that this development be rejected for the reasons outlined above.
