Dear Secretary,

We wish to make observations against the proposed installation of 17 industrial wind turbines in our area.

1. The height and scale of the turbines will change our beautiful scenery; they will be hugely intrusive in our agricultural/natural landscape.
2. We fear that more and more turbines will be in the county further eroding our rural charm and character, there are massive concerns about how green the actual long-term maintenance, servicing & eventual decommissioning of these wind turbines are.
3. Previous wind farms for example Derrybrien, Co Galway, (located out my parent's kitchen window!) which have proven to be hugely unsuccessful in terms of actual cost versus actual energy out.

Our objections for this project are endless we haven't mentioned the health risks to human or animals, noise pollution, the impact it will have on property values in the area etc. We trust you will carefully consider our points in making the final decision.
