Re: 10 year planning permission for Ballinlee Wind Farm consisting of 17 wind turbines, a permanent 110kV substation and ancillary development. Located in Ballincurra, Ballingayrou, Ballinlee North and South, Ballinrea, Ballinreesode, Camas North and South, Knockuregare, Ballybane and other townlands in County Limerick.

To Whom it may concern,

I, Jane Howe, write in connection with the above listed planning application.

I wish to strongly object to this proposal and respectfully ask that the board refuse planning permission.

My concerns are as follows:

1. My area is quiet and rural and the turbines would fundamentally change this, and have a serious negative impact on wildlife and biodiversity in the area.
2. I am concerned that my home will be impacted by constant low level noise and light shadow flicker leading to my health suffering (I have tinnitus)

3. I worry that my Family's home and farm will be devalued by the presence of the turbines now and into the future.

Finally, the application does not provide a clear plan to manage the impact it will have on local residents in relation to noise, shadow flicker or the disruption of animal habitats. The EIA R report acknowledges that certain wildlife species will be adversely affected, yet offers no meaningful mitigation strategy to prevent or offset this loss. Proceeding with the development despite known and unaddressed harm to protected species and residential wellbeing undermines the principles of proper planning and sustainable development.

I respectfully request that An Bord Pleanála refuse permission or require substantial further information to address these deficiencies.
