I am writing to formally object to the Strategic Infrastructure Application (case ref 323780).

I am writing to formally object to the proposed industrial wind turbines in my area. I am 94 years old and have lived in and owned my home here for many decades. This is not just a house to me, it is a place full of memories, that I dearly cherish, where my family has grown and where I have spent a lifetime enjoying the peace and beauty of this wonderful countryside. I have dearly watched the seasons change here for many years, walked the local roadways and admired the skies and natural landscapes that make this beautiful area so very, very special to me and my Children and my dear Grandchildren. The quiet and the calm of this place has been a source of comfort throughout my life. To see massive turbines built here would be totally heartbreaking.

They would dominate the views and change the character of this landscape, and take away the sense of peace and calm, that I, my family, and many others have always treasured.

I am also deeply concerned about the impact on my family. If these industrial turbines are approved, it will prevent my children and my grandchildren from building on our own land, something that has been part of our family for a long time. It feels totally unfair and heartbreaking that a commercial project could restrict the rights and opportunities of those who have cared for this area for so long.

While I fully support renewable energy and I totally understand the need to protect our environment, I do not believe that industrial turbines are appropriate in this location. The negative impact on my home, my family, my community and the surrounding landscape would be too great.

I respectfully ask that this application be totally refused, so that the beauty and peacefulness of this area can be preserved for my family, my community and for future generations to come.
