We wish to object strongly to this proposal and ask that the Board refuse planning permission.

Some of my summarised observations and concerns are as follows:

Case reference: PAX91.323780

I believe there was no public consultation with the community. The community is being affected. Bruff town is a populated area, not totally suitable for the likes of this industrial scale development.

Our lands at Ballygrennan and Rock Barton, Grange are both being made sterile by the proposal of these wind turbines.

Wildlife:

The wildlife is going to be affected. I notably see the badger who spreads TB and they will be forced out of their area and forced into ours causing the spread of TB.

Noise and visual aspect:

Totally unacceptable. *The application does not provide a clear or enforceable plan to manage the impact it will have on residents in relation to shadow flicker, noise, or the disruption of animal habitats.*

Personal impact:

I have a child who has down syndrome.

We value our peace and the landscapes that are in our countryside and dislike the destruction of the Golden Vale.

I respectfully request that An Bord Pleanála refuse permission or require substantial further information to address these deficiencies.
