**10-year planning permission for Ballinlee Wind Farm consisting of 17 no wind turbines, a permanent 110kV substation and ancillary development. Located in Ballincurra, Ballingayrou, Ballinlee North and South, Ballinrea, Ballyreesode, Camas North and South, Carrigeen, Knockuregare, Ballybane and other townlands in County Limerick.**

To whom it may concern,

I, Nuala Egan write in connection with the above listed planning application.

I wish to object strongly to the proposal and request that An Coimisiun Pleanála refuse planning permission.

My grounds for submission are as follows.

I am currently living in Bruff having moved from Dromin about 30 years ago. I've grown up in the Clogher region where my father came from. My husband and I moved from Dublin for a better quality of life for our children to Clogher in Dromin in the early 80s.

I am concerned that the proposed wind turbine development with the nearest turbine being approximately 1.5km from my house will negatively affect my health and wellbeing.

I am concerned about the noise, vibration and infrasound that could affect me living in close proximity to this proposed development. I routinely shop, go to church, use the local doctors and pharmacy in the town of Bruff. At the moment it can be difficult to park and I am concerned that the traffic management for this huge construction project is not sufficient.

The works involved in constructing the substation at the bottom of Ballinlee will involve massive amounts of construction traffic past my house and will leave me potentially isolated by restricting access to Bruff over a prolonged period of time.

In addition, I am concerned that it could impact my ability to travel to Dromin to visit my children and grandchildren in Dromin.

I am also concerned that my grandchildren will not have the opportunity to live and work in the area as there is potentially restrictions to planning permission near the vicinity of the turbines.

I respectfully request that An Coimisiun Pleanála refuse planning permission or require substantial further information to address these concerns.

I request for an oral hearing in relation to this wind farm application, for the reasons outlined above. In particular the impact of construction traffic near my home in Brackvoan and in Dromin where my family and grandchildren live
