

Subject: Objection to Proposed Solar Farm Development in Bruff

Dear Sir/Madam,

I wish to formally object to the proposed solar/wind farm development in Bruff.

I have serious concerns about the suitability of this particular site and the impact it will have on the local community.

The development would result in the permanent loss of productive agricultural land and significantly alter the visual character of the rural landscape. In addition, there are serious concerns about light flicker which could affect nearby homes and road users. The potential for noise pollution from inverters, transformers, and associated equipment is also troubling, especially given the quiet, residential nature of the surrounding area.

Furthermore, the project poses risks to local wildlife habitats and will bring increased traffic and disruption during construction. The scale of the proposal appears disproportionate to the local setting and lacks meaningful community consultation.

For these reasons, I respectfully urge the Council to refuse this application and to ensure that large-scale renewable energy projects are located in more appropriate areas (where they do not negatively impact rural communities, local amenity, or the environment).
