Dear Sir/Madam,

I wish to formally lodge my objection to the proposed wind turbine development in the Bruff area. As a parent of four children, I have deep concerns about the potential impact this development will have on my family's health, wellbeing, and long-term future in the community.

My biggest concern relates to my daughter, who suffers from severe asthma. Any environmental changes that may affect air quality may have serious consequences for her condition. As a parent, I cannot ignore the risks this development could pose to her already fragile health.

My family recently returned home to this area, my own hometown, with the intention of rearing our children in a safe, stable, rural environment. We came back so our children could grow up in the same community I did, surrounded by family, friends, and a strong sense of community. However, this proposed development has created significant uncertainty about whether our children will truly be able to build a future here.

We are deeply concerned about what this development—and future similar developments—might mean for our children in terms of their ability to live safely and healthily in this area, their opportunities to build homes of their own one day, and the long-term quality of life and community stability in a place that they have grown to call home.

We fear that ongoing industrial-scale projects in our rural area may restrict future planning possibilities for them.

I urge An Bord Pleanála to consider the profound impact this proposal would have on families like mine living in the locality.

For these reasons, I respectfully request that An Bord Pleanála refuse permission for this development.
