Dear Sir/Madam, (Case No 323780)

I write to you on behalf of Bruff, Dromin, Athlacca action group who contacted me about the development of a wind farm adjacent to my lands in Camas Bruff, objecting to the 17 turbines being erected.

We have horses grazing on our lands adjacent to the proposed development, and it is well documented that the noise and the shadow flicker coming from wind turbines has an adverse effect on horses and has safety implications for horse handlers and riders. Horses can see a full circle around themselves, have better sight in low light and are far more sensitive to sound frequencies than humans^[1]. "Noise anxiety" can have long term effects on food intake, growth and production rates.

For this reason, as well as the consequences for the habitat of the Whooper Swan and other birds on the Corcass, I support the objection of the Community to the Ballinleegreenenergy wind farm project in this low lying agricultural area.
