I, Breeda Cotter, Liscormick, Kildysart,
Co. Clare wish to formally object to the
proposed Cloonkett Wind Farm Development
at Cloonkett and Burrenfadha, Co. Clare.

These are my reasons for objecting:

1. Last Saturday morning on my way to work
I saw a wonderful sight. After all
the heavy rain on Friday night Sullivan's

field had a large lake of water on it. There
swimming away contentedly four beautiful
white swans and numerous ducks.

The wonder of nature!

It put me thinking of all we could possibly
lose as just a short distance up the road
a proposed wind farm. Fourteen turbines,
loud noise, long hours of heavy traffic
polluting the air and a loss of forestry
to other wildlife. A proposed development
located within a Freshwater Pearl Mussel
sub-catchment area and an area that is
home to foraging bats.

2. I am also concerned about the height of
the wind turbines and how visually
obtrusive they are to our landscape.
Mush's Co. Clare, home to the Burren, the
Loop Head Peninsula, The Cliffs of Moher
and The Wild Atlantic Way given up
enough. There are already fifteen
wind farms here. Our tourism needs to
be protected.
