

1. My first concern is the sheer magnitude of the Wind Farm Composing of 14 wind turbines with a tip height of 150 metres, hub height of 82 m, and a 136 m Rotor diameter, which is in close proximity to homes. One of these homes is my childhood home where my mother and brother reside. Turbine No. 14 is located less than 600 metres from the Cortelage of the residential property.
2. The noise pollution limit from these turbines is exceeded in 16 locations.
3. I am also concerned about the large volume of heavy traffic which will be travelling our local roads. These roads are not suitable as they are narrow and already in poor condition and therefore will not withstand volume of heavy traffic and vehicles.
4. The volume of turbines with magnetic fields can cause disturbance of our frequency platforms to broadband and television.
5. Forestry of 8.4 hectares has to be cut down to accommodate these turbines. This will result in a loss of our wonderful wildlife.



- *6 Development (Proposed) is located. Within a Freshwater. Pearl Mussel Sub-Catchment area and an area that is home to bats.
- *7 Craghera bog is mapped out. as a route for transportation for turbines and concrete. Will these bog owners including my family have access to their road during construction. Again these roads are not suitable for heavy traffic and large vehicles.
- 8 Site is close to Gortglass lake which is a water reservoir for local area. It is a popular angling and recreational lake stocked with fish and used by community. I fear a decline in water quality through chemicals leaching and microplastic contamination.

Overall I feel West Clare has several wind farms. as it stands. Our wildlife needs to be protected our water supplies our beautiful countryside and our heritage sites.
