Development Location:

The proposed development is located within the townlands of Scartmountain, Newtown, Coolroe, Staigbraud, Graigue Beg, Carrigaun (Hely), Graigue More, Scart (Hely), Scart (Sergant), Vicarstown South, Glen Lower, Glen Upper, Lisroe, Carrowgarrif Beg, Colligan More, Colliganmountain, Colliganwood, Ballymacmague North, Inchindrislawood, Inchindrisla, and Killadangan Co. Waterford.

Development Description:

All works associated with the connection of the proposed wind farm to the national electricity grid, which will be via a permanent tail fed 110 kV underground cable connection (approximately 15.5 km cable length of which approximately 13.3 km will be in the public road corridor) to the existing 110 kV Dungarvan Substation in the townland of Killadangan, Co. Waterford.

This application, and the wind farm application (ACP Ref. 321522) are functionally interdependent and constitute a single project.

A Chara,

Uisce Éireann (UÉ) has reviewed the plans and particulars submitted with the application specifically the Planning Statement, and Chapter 9 (Hydrology & Hydrogeology) and Chapter 11 (Material Assets, Chapter 19 (Schedule of Mitigations) of the EIAR and have the following observations.

Connections to Public Infrastructure

No connections to public water or wastewater are proposed as part of this development.

Interactions with Uisce Éireann Assets

The proposed 110kv underground cable is significant infrastructure and any interaction with public watermains and/or infrastructure needs to be carefully considered in order to ensure the public assets are adequately protected.

Structures or works over or in close proximity to UÉ infrastructure that may inhibit

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access for maintenance or endanger structural or functional integrity of the infrastructure are not permitted and separation distances shall be in accordance with the UÉ Codes of Practice and Standard Details.

Where building near / building over / diversions of existing Uisce Éireann assets are proposed, the associated designs need to be agreed with the Uisce Éireann Diversions team, a Confirmation of Feasibility must be issued and where appropriate an associated Build Over Agreement / Diversion Agreement executed between the applicant and Uisce Éireann before planning permission is granted.

In order to ensure appropriate access to and protection of Uisce Éireann assets along the proposed route, Uisce Éireann requests the applicant is required to submit a Diversion Application to the Uisce Éireann Diversions team in order to assess the interactions with public water infrastructure. The outcome of the Diversion Application and the Confirmation of Feasibility should be submitted to An Pleanála as a response to this further information request.

It is noted that Uisce Éireann flagged the need to engage on these interactions in the letter to An Bord Pleanála dated 25 February 2025 for the associated Strategic Infrastructure Development PA93.321522.
