The construction of a new road, pedestrian footpaths, and cycle lanes as part of an active travel corridor known as the Celbridge Hazelhatch Mobility Corridor, located in Celbridge Town, County Kildare. The proposed corridor spans approximately 2km, commencing at a new junction with Clane Road (R403) and extending southeast through predominantly greenfield lands. The corridor connects with the R405 Hazelhatch Road and terminates at the Loughlinstown Road Roundabout near Hazelhatch and Celbridge Train Station.

In our opinion, the appropriate development consent statutory process is an application to An Bord Pleanála for consent for proposed development under Part XAB, Section 177AE, of the Planning and Development Act 2000 -2025(as amended).

Kildare County Council hereby makes an application to An Coimisiún Pleanála for consent for the proposed development under Section 177AE of the Planning and Development Acts 2000-2025 (as amended).

A Compulsory Purchase Order, to which the proposed road development relates, has been made be Kildare County Council and will be submitted to An Bord Pleanála under separate cover.
