Dear Sir / Madam,

I refer to the additional information received by the Commission in relation to the likely effects on the environment of the above-mentioned proposed development. Please be advised that the Commission considers that this additional information contains significant additional data in relation to the effects on the environment of the proposed development and it therefore requires you in accordance with section 2(b) of 37F of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, to:

(a) publish in one or more newspapers circulating in the area in which the proposed development would take place a notice stating that significant additional information in relation to the said effects has been furnished to the Commission, that the additional information will be available, for inspection or for purchase (upon payment of a specified fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy), at a specified place and at specified times during a specified period, and that submissions or observations in relation to the additional information may be made in writing to the Commission before a specified date (which shall not be less than 30 days), and update the stand-alone website stating that the additional information can be downloaded, and

(b) send notice of the furnishing to the Commission of significant additional information and a copy of the additional information, to the planning authority and to the prescribed bodies stating that submissions or observations in relation to the additional information may be made in writing to the Commission before a specified date (which shall not be less than 30 days).

Having regard to the above a sample public notice is enclosed for your convenience. You are requested to revert to the Commission with a draft public notice prior to publication, for approval.

- (ii) The likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, if carried out.
- (iii) The likely significant effects of the proposed development on a European site, if carried out.

Any submissions/observations must be accompanied by a fee of €50 (except for certain prescribed bodies). There is no fee required to make a submission in relation to those parties/individuals who have already made a valid written submission to the Commission regarding the application. Submissions or observations must be received by the Commission no later than **5.30 p.m. on the (insert date) 202X**. Such submissions/observations must also include the following information:

- (i) The name of the person making the submission or observation, the name of the person acting on his or her behalf, if any, and the address to which any correspondence relating to the application should be sent.
- (ii) The subject matter of the submission or observation, and
- (iii) The reasons, considerations and arguments on which the submission or observation is based in full.

Any submissions or observations which do not comply with the above requirements cannot be considered by the Commission.

A person may question the validity of any such decision by the Commission by way of an application for judicial review, under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I.
