Re: Section 177AE (4)(b) - Prescribed Authority Addendum Notice

Further to the notice issued on 18/12/2025, and pursuant to the provisions of Section 177AE (4)(b) of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as inserted by Section 57 of the Planning & Development (Amendment) Act 2010), notice is hereby given that Donegal County Council (Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall) proposes to seek approval from An Bord Pleanála under the provisions of Section 177AE of the Planning & Development Act 2000 to carry out development works at Port Pier, Inver, Co Donegal.

The development works will include the construction of a new pier south of the existing pier, construction of a new sheet-piled retaining wall, dredging and reclamation to provide deeper access and additional quay-side area and berthing facilities.

A Natura Impact Statement (NIS) has been prepared for the proposed development.

An Bord Pleanála may approve the development with or without conditions or refuse the application.
