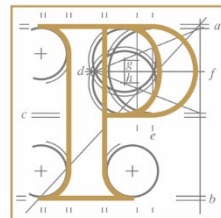

Dear Sir / Madam,

I have been asked by An Coimisiún Pleanála to refer further to the above-mentioned application, and, in particular, to your email to the Commission dated 24th March 2026. The Commission notes the content of your email and asks that you note the following in response to the issues raised:

1. As the deadline for receipt of submissions stated in your most recent site notice did not match the deadline stated in your addendum newspaper notice published in the Irish Independent on 18th December 2025, the Commission considers it necessary to request that you publish an addendum newspaper notice and update the notice erected at the site in order to correct this error. As such, you are hereby requested to execute the following:
 - (a) Publish an addendum notice in one or more newspapers circulating in the area in which the proposed development would take place, stating that the public consultation period has reopened and that submissions or observations in relation to the application for the proposed development may be made in writing to the Commission during a specified period. The Commission asks that you have regard to the requirements of section 177AE(4)(a) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, when preparing the notice. The notice should be titled "Addendum Newspaper Notice" and should refer to the previous newspaper notice.
 - (b) Send notice of the publishing of the addendum notice to the bodies and persons referred to in section 177AE(4)(b) and to indicate to such bodies and persons, that public consultation period has reopened and that submissions or observations in relation to the application for the proposed development may be made in writing to the Commission during a specified.
 - (c) Erect an updated site notice to replace the notice currently erected at the site of the proposed development, ensuring that the content of the site notice corresponds with the content of the requested addendum newspaper notice in (a) above.

In respect of (a) above, the notices should be published in the same newspapers in which the original notice and subsequent addendum notice of the application were advertised, and the application documents should be made available for inspection or purchase at the same locations at which the application documentation was originally available. In respect of the time limits for the making of submissions or observations in relation to the application for the proposed development to the Commission under (a) and (b) above, please indicate the specified time limit for the receipt of submissions to be no less than 6 weeks.

You should submit the relevant newspaper notices and a copy of any notices issued under (b) above to the Commission as soon as same are available. Please be advised that you may submit a draft of the newspaper notice to the undersigned officer of the Commission for review prior to publication.

Your response to this request should be received on or before 23rd April 2026.

2. Additionally, the Commission refers to its previous letter to you dated 24th February 2026, within which you were invited to submit, by 23rd March 2026, your response to the submissions/observations received in relation to this application. It is noted that, on 24th March 2026, you submitted a request for an extension of time to submit your response to the submissions/observations. Considering the necessity for the publishing of addendum notices, the Commission now considers it appropriate to request that you submit your response to all submissions received in relation to this application after the public consultation period in the requested addendum notices ends. The Commission will revert to you with a response deadline in relation to this after this reopened public consultation period has ended.
